

Some pupils are switched off long before they reach Year 6. They're stuck in reading, anxious in writing, and adrift in lessons. Many still rely on memorised sight words, struggle to decode unfamiliar language, or fear being asked to read aloud. They're behind - but capable. They need a new way in.

We teach the structure of language - roots, prefixes, and suffixes - so learners can break down unfamiliar words, build vocabulary resilience, and regain confidence in reading and writing. Key Focus

Pupils construct multi-morpheme words, explore suffix meanings, and embed decoding across subjects.



How the Journey Works

Each half-term builds on the last. Root knowledge grows into sentence strength. Confidence grows into fluency.

Vocabulary becomes power - and learners carry that power into SATs and secondary school. *Word Roots* isn't about short-term tricks. It's a long-term re-entry point into reading.



Who It's For

- Year 5–6 pupils with reading below expected
- Learners stuck in phonics, or guessing words
- Pupils anxious or disengaged from reading
- Students with weak vocabulary, writing fluency or decoding confidence
- Children with SEND, SEMH, EAL or transition needs
- Schools needing evidence-based, rapid literacy reengagement
- Learners in Alternative Provision, or those at risk of exclusion, disengagement, or withdrawal from mainstream

Our Delivery Model

Our groups are capped at 12 to maximise engagement, nurture confidence, and support meaningful connection. Learners build trust with the facilitator and with each other - critical for those who have experienced failure, anxiety or frustration in whole-class lessons.

- Weekly attendance and engagement tracking
- Termly progress reports with literacy focus
- Evidenced growth in decoding, vocabulary, writing and comprehension
- Increased learner confidence & classroom re-entry readiness

Commissioning & Booking

- Weekly small-group online sessions (max 12 learners)
