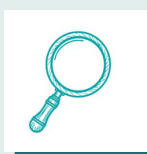


# Year 11 GCSE English Language - 30-Week Intensive Course

Re-engage learners, rebuild writing fluency and exam habits, and secure readiness for GCSE English Language.



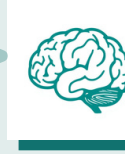
## Phase 1 · Paper 1 Reading Mastery - Weeks 1–7

Decode, analyse and evaluate narrative writing with structured methods & retrieval.



## Phase 2 · Writing Mastery - Weeks 8–10

Craft descriptive/narrative responses: imagery, clarity, dialogue, control.



## Phase 3 · Viewpoints & Perspectives - Weeks 11–16

Compare, summarise and detect bias; build purposeful language choices.



## Phase 4 · Transactional Writing - Weeks 17–19

Organise extended responses; coherence, flow and paragraphing.



## Phase 5 · Retrieval Extension - Weeks 20–22

Tone, symbolism and irony; extend precision under timed conditions.



## Phase 6 · Exam Simulation & Revision - Weeks 23–26

Timed practice + mixed Paper 1/2 mocks; feedback loops and reteach.



## Phase 7 · Confidence & Exam Craft - Weeks 27–30

Strategies, reflection, targeted fixes and exam-day readiness.

### What students get (weekly)

- Live, interactive teaching (2×60 mins), small groups (5–15).
- Morphology-first vocabulary embedded across reading & writing.
- Weekly SPaG/writing micro-focus (comma splice, cohesion, COPS).
- Curated texts & exam-style tasks (Paper 1 & 2).
- Structured feedback with clear personal next steps.

### How progress is tracked

- Baseline (Week 0) → diagnostic profile + target setting.
- Checkpoint Week 10 & 20 → extended responses + personal next steps.
- Weekly attendance → live tracker; data-led coaching.
- Mocks (Weeks 23–26) → Paper 1 & 2 timed practice with focused reteach.
